- Dialogue practice and role-playing

Week 6:

- Talking about family and personal relationships
- Vocabulary for family members and descriptions
- Listening comprehension activities

Week 7:

- Describing locations and places of interest
- Vocabulary for describing cities and landmarks
- Writing practice and group discussions

Week 8:

- Cultural topics and customs in Israel
- Vocabulary related to Israeli culture and traditions
- Review sessions and final assessment
