- Numbers and dates in the Bible
- Vocabulary related to time expressions and genealogies
- Reading and comprehension exercises from the Book of Exodus

Week 3:

- Expressing emotions and actions in the Bible
- Vocabulary for feelings, verbs, and actions
- Analyzing selected Psalms and Proverbs

Week 4:

- Describing people and places in the Bible
- Vocabulary for physical descriptions and geographical locations

Week 5:

- The Ten Commandments and the Law in the Bible
- Vocabulary for legal terms and commandments
- Reading and analyzing the Book of Deuteronomy

Week 6:

- Prophets and prophecies in the Bible
- Vocabulary for prophetic language and terminology
- Reading selected passages from Isaiah and Jeremiah

<u>Week 7:</u>

- Stories and parables in the Bible
- Vocabulary for narrative elements and moral teachings
- Analyzing selected stories from the Hebrew Bible

<u>Week 8:</u>

- · Names of biblical figures, places, and books
- Vocabulary for significant biblical names and terms
- Reading and comprehension exercises from various biblical texts



<u>Note:</u> The syllabus can be customized to focus on a specific biblical text or theme based on the group's preferences. A meeting can be conducted to discuss the specific needs of religious groups, and a religious leader is encouraged to join for theological discussions following the class.
